- holds a practising certificate, or
- have held a practising certificate (within the past three years).

If you have information to disclose, please make a disclosure via your online portal. You are not required to disclose information that the Pharmacy Council is already aware of.

During alert level 4 travel between regions is heavily restricted and pharmacists with health conditions must consider their own safety before expressing interest.

Pharmacy Requesting Assistance

If you and/or the pharmacy you are working in need additional or relieving pharmacists, please contact (via your pharmacy manager / owner) your local DHB portfolio manager as soon as possible. Portfolio managers will collate responses and feedback to the Council.

Once a pharmacist and requirement for a pharmacist are linked, a practising certificate may be issued.
