

Ms Kitty Samarasinha – Phar16/365P

Charge

On 02 November 2016 the Health Practitioners Disciplinary Tribunal considered a charge laid by the Professional Conduct Committee against Ms Kitty Samarasinha, pharmacist of Auckland.

The charge alleged that the pharmacist practised as a pharmacist between 01 April and 22 April 2015 without a current practising certificate.

The hearing proceeded on a defended basis.

Finding

The Tribunal found the charge made out and disciplinary sanction was warranted.

Penalty

The Tribunal censured the pharmacist and ordered that she pay a fine of \$800. Additionally, the Tribunal order the pharmacist to pay a total of \$8,000 towards the costs of the PCC and Tribunal.
