

Pharmacy Council (Fees) Notice 2020

Pursuant to sections 130 to 133 of the Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act 2003, the following notice is given.

This notice is effective from **21 February 2020** and revokes and replaces all previous Pharmacy Council fees notices.

Notice

1. Title and commencement—This notice may be cited as the Pharmacy Council (Fees) Notice 2020 and shall come into force on **21 February 2020**.

2. Fees and Levies —The Pharmacy Council sets the following fees and levies, payable to the Council, specified in the attached Schedule.
