Why we decided to do this learning activity

We wanted to find out more about the FIP self-assessment tool for preparedness of Pharmacy Based Vaccinations.

Summary of main learning points

- The self-assessment tool provides FIP members, member countries and self-identified regulators an evaluation of preparedness, risk and priorities regarding a pharmacy-based programme to enhance vaccination, testing and treatment during a pandemic (pharmacy-based vaccinations).
- The tool covers four main areas:
 - Vaccination by pharmacist and pharmacy staff
 - Administer tests (ex. performing nasal swabs)
 - Prescribing of vaccines, other chronic medications and minor treatments
 - Supply chain management
