Case 1 presented by WM Are non-medical prescribers treated any differently from medical prescribers in electronic systems? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dependent on scope of practitioner. If professional organisation dictates medications that can or cannot be prescribed these can be reflected within a system – some organisations implement this, others rely on professional accountability. • Have had issues with some systems only recognising prescriber numbers in the format of numbers – some other practitioners have use letters in their prescribing registrations • Some systems have traditionally referred to “doctor” and “nurse” roles – BB mentioned work underway to rename to “prescriber” and “administrator”. Some roles such as midwives have both these components. • Trainee Interns & students broached as a discussion but to be revisited at next meeting
